

# Wise Guy Wednesday

**Q: Hey Wise Guy:** I've gone over my Vette many times. I think I've got it as good as I can get it to meet the judging standards at Bloomington. Now I'm just checking last minute details. What last minute suggestions would you give me to make sure I'm ready? *Larry*



**A: Last-Minute Larry:** Great question because everyone is preparing for judging and you and every one else wants to make sure they don't miss any easy items.

As you get your Corvette prepared for Bloomington Gold Standard Judging, you will undoubtedly go through significant effort to make sure your car is as authentic as possible to how it left the factory. In that preparation process, don't forget the *easy items*. When you present your Corvette for judging it should be just as it left the factory, *and* include all the items that came with the Corvette. Those items will include all or some of the following and the judges *will* look for them;

- Window Sticker – they came with one. It can be original or a reproduction
- Owners manual, warranty books, and envelope
- Radio instructions, instructions on sun visor
- Two sets of keys & key envelope
- Complete jack, hold down spring, wrench
- Instruction labels in the storage compartments

Last but not least, check the operations of everything one last time; headlights, turn signals, gauges, lighter, heater fan, etc.

You do NOT need to bring dealer supplied items such as; order forms, Chevrolet brochure, sales receipts, etc. Remember – only items that came with the car **when it left the factory**...Don't forget these items/ documents. They are the *easy items/ points*.
